as an itinerant print peddler a horse trainer in hungary and a gardener in a prague castle but every winter he returns secretly to his home and family until finally a pardon is granted by now his children are grown and he has little to do but tend his sheep meanwhile the times are changing social values are disintegrating under the impact of modernization and europe moves ever closer to disaster during the devastation of the first world war the occupation and ultimate destruction of his village and his own internment in an austrian camp it is tonle s loyalty to his roots and his stubborn devotion to his task as a shepherd that persist and make him a quiet symbol of heroism and human endurance
